



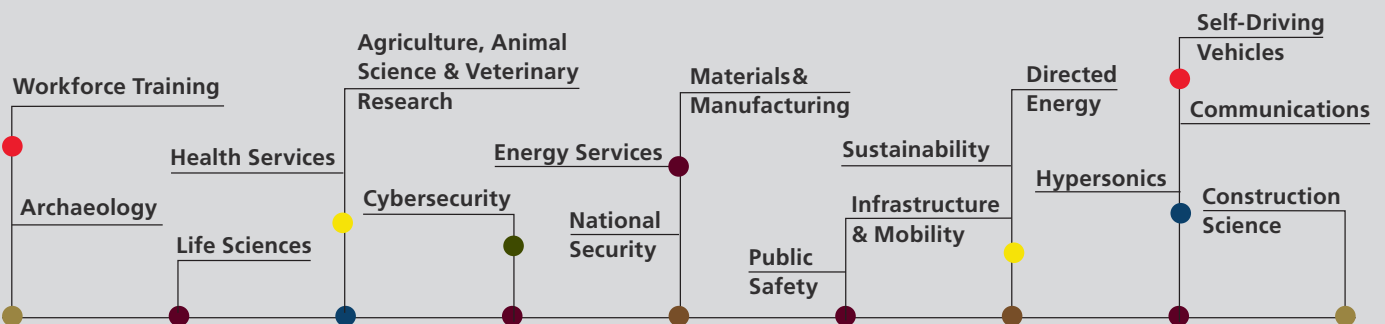

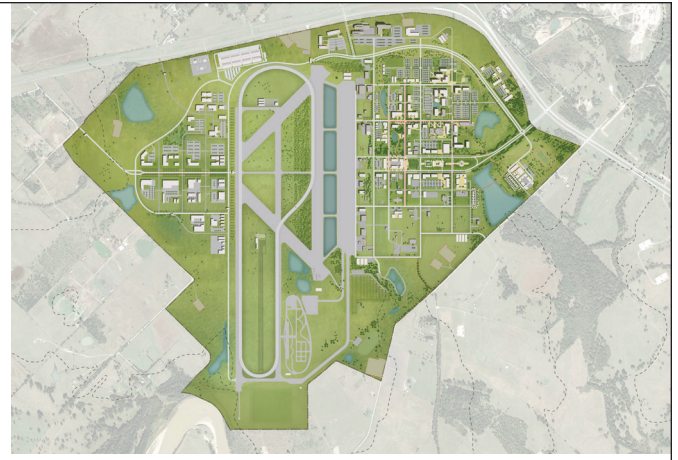

Partnering with Industry

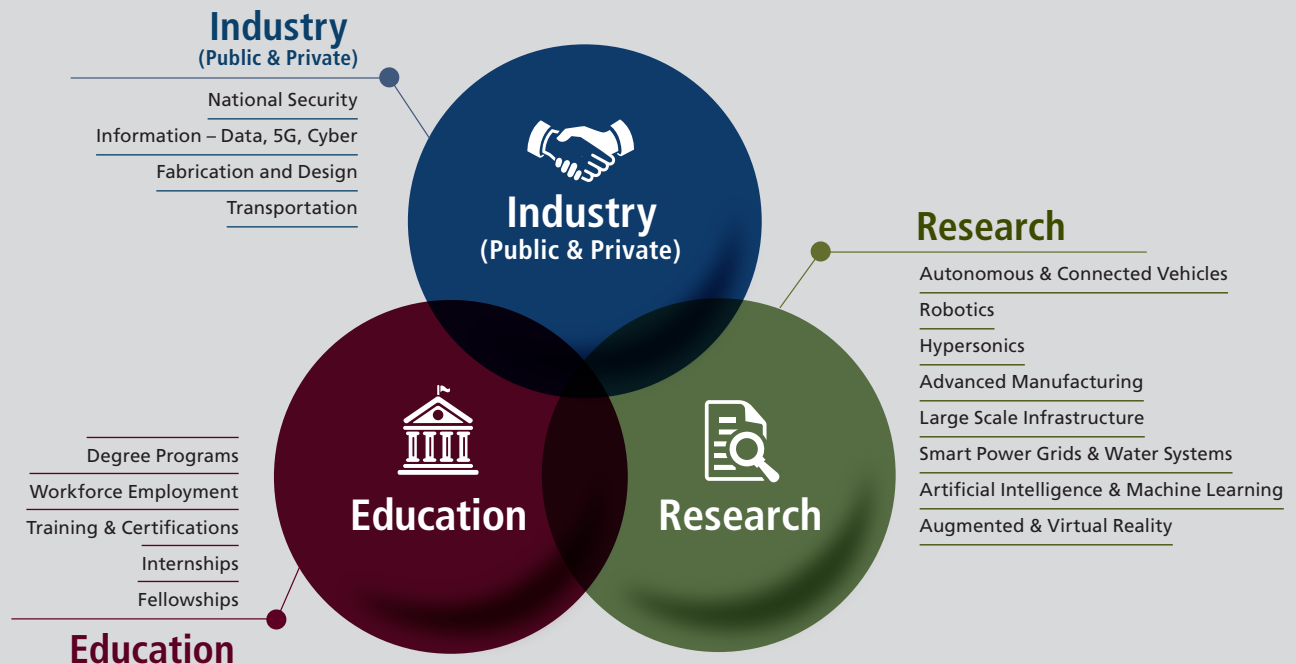
At the RELLIS Campus, innovation flourishes.
